Dendrobium 	Ideal 85-65° Tolerates 90-50°	50-70% Air Moving	Bright Dappled	Once a Week	Weekly-Weakly Water Soluble	When it Outgrows The Pot
Oncidium 	Ideal 85-60° Tolerates 90-50°	50-60% Air Moving	Bright Dappled	Once a Week	Weekly-Weakly Water Soluble	Every 2 Years

Paphiopedilum 	Ideal 80-60° Tolerates 90-50°	40-50% Air Moving	Shade	Evenly Moist	Weekly-Weakly Water Soluble	When it Outgrows The Pot
Phalenopsis 	Ideal 75-65° Tolerates 90-60°	50-70% Air Moving	Shade	Once a Week	Weekly-Weakly Water Soluble	Every 1-2 Years
Vanda 	Ideal 85-55° Tolerates 95-45°	80% Air Moving	Brightest Light	Daily	Weak Water Soluble Solution Daily	When it Outgrows Basket

These are basic orchid care instructions; watering may vary. We recommend using a pencil to check for moisture. Insert pencil at a 45 degree angle to the core; after a few seconds remove pencil.
